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**RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK J. (ORAL)**

Present revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, at the hands of defendant, is directed against the order dated 27.7.2017 (Annexure P-6) passed by the learned trial court, whereby application of the plaintiff permitting her to get the thumb impressions of the deceased namely late Sh. Chhenna Singh compared with his admitted thumb impressions in the bank records by a Fingerprints and Handwriting Expert was allowed.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

The only argument raised by learned counsel for the petitioner was that petitioner has no objection in case thumb impressions of the deceased-Chhenna Singh are got compared with his admitted thumb impressions available in the record of Syndicate Bank, Chhainsha, Faridabad and also from the Aadhaar Card.

The impugned order passed by the learned trial court has not been found suffering from any patent illegality or perversity. It is so said, because thumb impressions of the deceased, which are sought to be got

compared, are being taken from proper custody of the Bank and there would be no scope of any fabrication and interpolation. In this view of the matter, no fault can be found with the impugned order and the same deserves to be upheld.

Keeping in view the totality of facts and circumstances of the case, noted above, present revision petition is disposed of, with an observation that in case the learned trial court finds it necessary at a later point of time that thumb impressions of the deceased also requires to be got compared with his thumb impression on Aadhaar Card, it shall be open to the learned trial court to do so.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present revision petition stands disposed of.
