Feeling aggrieved against the order dated 24.8.2016, whereby misc. appeal of the plaintiff against the order dated 29.4.2015 passed by the learned trial court was partly allowed by the learned District Judge, plaintiff has approached this Court by way of instant civil revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, for setting aside the impugned order.

Notice of motion was issued.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

After arguing the case for some time and then having clear instructions from Shri Anil Kumar Jain, husband of the petitioner, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of the court to withdraw the present civil revision petition. However, he prays that appropriate direction may be issued to the learned trial court for deciding the suit at an early date.

Learned counsel for the respondent also fairly states that he is not averse to the proposal put forth by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, instant civil revision petition is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn. However, keeping in view the controversy between the parties and their inter se relationship, the learned trial court is directed to make an endeavour to decide the suit as early as possible.

Disposed of, accordingly.
