RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)

Feeling aggrieved against the impugned order dated 08.11.2016 passed by the learned trial Court, rejecting the application of the applicant-petitioner, praying for a direction to the plaintiff to restrict his affidavit only qua maintainability of the suit, defendant has approached this Court by way of present revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, for setting aside the impugned order.

After arguing the case at some length and realizing that she would not be in a position to substantiate her arguments on merits, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let the learned trial Court be directed to expedite the trial of the suit and conclude the same at an early date.

In view of above statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, present revision petition is disposed of, upholding the impugned order dated 08.11.2016, however, the learned trial Court is directed to make an

endeavour to decide the case as early as possible, granting reasonable opportunity to both the parties.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, instant revision petition stands disposed of.
