Present revision is directed against the order dated 13.10.2016, passed by the trial court, whereby application for recalling the petitioner namely, Ajay Khanna, who appeared as DW-1, was rejected.

It appears, plaintiff filed a suit seeking mandatory injunction to direct the defendant bank to return unused blank cheques of the plaintiff. Stand of the bank is that No Objection Certificate has already been issued to the petitioner. An official of the bank appeared as DW-1 before the court below and stated that on expiry of 30 days, cheques issued by the plaintiff had been destroyed. There is, thus, no question of misutilization of the same. He further submits that apprehension of the petitioner that he would be harassed by the bank, is misconceived.

In view of above, no further direction is necessary.
