In this petition, the challenge is to order dated 26.08.2015 (Annexure P6) passed by learned Additional District Judge, Amritsar, whereby, an application filed by the petitioner under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 for grant of maintenance pendente-lite was dismissed.

Learned counsel for the respondent states that the revision petition has become infructuous in view of grant of decree of divorce by the learned Additional District Judge, Amritsar and FAO-M-333 of 2016 has been filed against the grant of decree of divorce by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner while admitting the factual aspect of the matter, states that he does not press the present revision petition and the same may be dismissed as having become infructuous with liberty to avail the remedy available to the petitioner for seeking maintenance under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 in accordance with law.

In view of the above, the Revision petition is dismissed as having become infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
