Counsel for the petitioner submits that a compromise has been effected between the parties, as such, on 16.01.2017. Copy of the same is placed on record. It is submitted that the possession of the premises in dispute will be handed-over and Narinder Singh would not claim any rent or arrears of rent etc. Accordingly, prayer has been made that the present revision petition may be dismissed as withdrawn.

Resultantly, keeping in view the above, which is not disputed by the proxy counsel for the respondent and in view of the compromise effected between the parties, the present revision petition stands dismissed as withdrawn. Interim order dated 13.10.2014, accordingly, stands vacated. Parties shall abide by the terms and conditions of the above-said compromise.
