Challenge in the present revision petition is to the order dated 12.04.2014 (Annexure P7) passed by the Rent Controller, Dasuya, whereby the application for assessment of provisional rent had been dismissed on the ground that the respondent had taken the plea that he was not in possession of the property.

Counsel for the respondent is not in a position to confirm whether the eviction petition has been decided or not.

Keeping in view the above and the fact that the order impugned was passed more than 3 years back, this Court is of the opinion that the present revision petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of, as such.
