“On 11.1.2017, following order was passed:-

*“Learned counsel appearing for the
petitioner prays for time to ascertain the status
of service on unserved respondent(s), if any.
He may take necessary steps within a week
failing which this revision petition shall be
deemed to have been dismissed for non-
prosecution. Adjourned to 19.5.2017.”*

*As per office report, no steps have been
taken by learned counsel for the petitioner for
the service of un-served respondents. In the*

light of aforesaid order, this revision has to be dismissed on account of deemed fiction attached to the said order.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks time to verify the factum of filing of process fee by his office (if any).

Adjourned to 28.9.2017.

Today, learned counsel for the petitioner has shown his helplessness in the matter in the context of serving the unserved respondents for want of bringing on record legal representatives of respondent No.2 as well as for correct address of respondent No.3.

Learned counsel submits that despite his whole hearted effort, the petitioner has not come forward to provide the necessary information.

Faced with this situation, this Court has no alternative but to dismiss the revision petition for non-prosecution.
