Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that two identical civil suits pending between these very parties before the same court may be ordered to be clubbed together, which will serve the purpose and would also not cause any kind of prejudice to either of the parties.

In view of the abovesaid common and fair stand taken on behalf of both the parties, present revision petition is disposed of with a direction to the learned trial Court, to pass an appropriate order clubbing both the civil suits pending between the parties so as to avoid inconsistent orders in both the civil suits. Should there be any ambiguity in this regard, it is clarified that both the parties would be at liberty to move an appropriate application before the learned trial Court for clubbing of both the suits together. Once any such application is moved by either of the parties, learned trial Court shall pass appropriate orders thereon, in accordance with

law. It is also directed that after clubbing both the civil suits, learned trial Court shall proceed further to decide both the suits together, in accordance with law.

Resultantly, with the above-said observations made and directions issued, instant revision petition stands disposed of.
