The Sixteen petitioners were appointed as Senior Laboratory Attendants in the periods from 1975 to 1987 on different dates under the employment of the Director of Public Instructions (Schools), Punjab (respondent No.2). During their services, they have improved their qualifications and thus possess B.A./M.A./B.Ed. Thus, they have set up a claim for consideration to the post of Master/Mistress on having acquired the prescribed qualification.

This petition was listed on 10.11.1994 and the following order was passed:-

“ *To come up after the decision of CWP No.11837 of 1993. The deficiency in the Court fee be made good by 30.11.1994.* ”

At the time of hearing, it is conceded that the claim of similarly situated employees set up in CWP No.11837 of 1993 has since been rejected by passing a detailed order on 28.03.1995.

The learned Single Judge has held that the petitioner(s) are not entitled to either absorption as Master having worked for short periods as

Teachers although in the substantive rank of Senior Laboratory Attendant nor can set up a claim for promotion under the statutory Rules as there is no channel of promotion to the post of Master/Mistress from the Non-Teaching Cadre of Clerks, Senior Laboratory Attendants etc.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed in the same terms as passed in CWP No.11837 of 1993, dismissed vide judgment dated 28.03.1995.
