REKHA MITTAL, J.(Oral)

The precise grievance of the petitioner is that miscellaneous appeal filed by the petitioner against order passed by the trial Court dismissing application for grant of interim injunction has not been disposed of despite the parties have already made submissions and the petitioner has even submitted his written submissions before the Court below. It is further submitted that since 11.07.2017 the case has been adjourned on more than 15 occasions stating the case to be adjourned for arguments. It is prayed that some time-bound directions may be issued to the Court below for disposal of the appeal.

Perusal of the information received from the website of the concerned district (Annexure P-4) substantiates plea of the petitioner that the appeal has been adjourned for more than 15 occasions for arguments. Without examining correctness of the allegations that the parties have already submitted their arguments or otherwise, the petition stands disposed of with a direction to the Court below to dispose of the appeal within a period of 10 days from the next date i.e. 17.10.2017, in accordance with law.
