The instant writ petition has been filed in the year 1995, seeking to challenge the select list, which had been prepared, exclusively on the basis of oral test for appointment on the post of Block Development and Panchayat Officer, with a further direction to make a fresh select list on the basis of written test and marks provided for interview.

Vide order dated 18.12.1995, the petitioner herein was given liberty to amend the writ petition and also to implead the selected candidates.

The record reveals that no such application has been filed seeking either to amend the writ petition or to implead the selected candidates. This matter was listed before this court after due information to

the counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner, despite matter having been called twice.

In view of the fact that neither the amended writ petition has been filed nor the selected candidates have brought on the record, this court is not inclined to interfere with the matter, in the absence of the selected candidates. This writ petition is being dismissed for want of prosecution. However, in the interest of justice, in case the petitioner has any grievance, three month's time is granted to the petitioner to get the petition revived.

The petition stands dismissed in the aforesaid terms.
