Petitioners have challenged the order dated 18.8.2017, dismissing the application for recall/withdrawal of warrant of possession.

It is not in dispute that Chanan Singh and other persons filed a suit in which the petitioners were defendants. The suit was decreed. Petitioners filed an appeal, which was also dismissed. However, the petitioners were granted liberty to seek relief against their vendor with respect to other land apart from the land in dispute in the present litigation.

It is the case of the petitioners that they did file a suit, which has been decreed.

However, now the petitioners are wanting to stall the execution of decree in favour of Chanan Singh and others. That decree has become final. Petitioners were party to the aforesaid decree. Therefore, the decree passed in favour of Chanan Singh and others has to be given effect to.

For the reasons recorded above, there is no scope for interference in the impugned order passed by the court below.

The revision petition stands dismissed.
