The present petition directs challenge against order dated 12.09.2017 (Annexure P4) passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Chandigarh whereby evidence of the petitioners/defendants has been closed by order of the Court.

Counsel for the petitioners would pray that one effective opportunity may be allowed to adduce remaining evidence.

Counsel for the respondent/plaintiff, on the contrary, has contested the plea on the premise that the petitioners availed umpteen number of opportunities for leading evidence and there is no justification to allow another opportunity for the purpose. In addition, it is argued that the petitioners have already filed an application for adducing additional evidence and the same is pending consideration before the trial Court.

Without going into merits of the case, the present petition stands disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to file an appropriate

application before the Court below in the light of judgment of this Court ***State of Punjab and others vs. Ajmer Singh***, 2009(2) R.C.R.(Rent) 169. In case such an application is filed by the petitioners, the same shall be decided by the Court after providing an opportunity of hearing to the parties, in accordance with law.
