JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner-tenant is in revision directed against the judgment of reversal dated 15.09.2014 passed by the Appellate Authority, Gurgaon, whereby the tenant has been ordered to be evicted from the demised shop bearing House Tax Assessment Register No. 19, situated in Ward No. 6, Sohna, on the ground of '*bona fide personal necessity and subletting*', while setting aside the judgment dated 23.03.2012 passed by the Rent Controller, Gurgaon dismissing the eviction petition.

At the time of hearing, learned counsel for the the petitioner-tenant stated at the Bar that since the possession has been handed over to the landlord, therefore, the present petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
