After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that the petitioners would be satisfied, if the petition is disposed of by directing learned trial Court to frame issues regarding the jurisdiction of the Court and to decide the same after evidence is led by the parties.

A perusal of the order of the learned Civil Judge, Jr. Division, Ajnala dated 14.07.2017, reveals that the prayer made for by the learned counsel for the petitioners is well taken care of in the order itself, inasmuch as the learned trial Court has recorded that the issue of jurisdiction of the Court would be decided only after evidence is led by the parties. Obviously the same would be after issue is framed in respect thereto.

Besides, it would always open to the petitioners to move an application under Order 14 Rule 5 of the CPC, in order to get the appropriate issue/additional issue framed.
