[1]. This revision petition has been filed for seeking directions to the trial Court to expeditiously dispose of the application filed by the petitioner which is pending for more than 5 years as on date.

[2]. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the *ex parte* stay was granted on 10.04.2012. In the earlier Civil Revision No.8136 of 2015, the order was passed directing the trial Court to proceed strictly in accordance with law and decide the pending application as expeditiously as possible without giving undue adjournments. The said revision petition was disposed of on 02.12.2015. Thereafter, CM No.11362-CII of

2017 was filed in the said revision petition which was ultimately allowed to be withdrawn so as to avail any other remedy in accordance with law.

[3]. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

[4]. In view of facts and circumstances, this revision petition is disposed of by directing the trial Court to make sincere endeavour to dispose of the pending application for vacation of stay at the earliest preferably within a period of two months from the next date of hearing.
