Plaintiffs-petitioners are in revision petition against order dated
03.10.2017.

Municipal Corporation Faridabad was proceeded against ex-
parte. A revision petition was filed in this Court. The ex-parte proceedings
were set aside on the condition that Corporation shall pay a cost of
Rs.10,000/- within a period of 6 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of
the order.

It is the grievance of the plaintiffs-petitioners that the aforesaid
order has not been complied with and the payment as directed has not been
paid within time, although it is admitted that the cost as awarded by this
Court has been deposited.

Learned trial Court has noticed facts in detail and has held that
substantive compliance has been made.

In any case, the Court always has a power to extend the time.

Taking into consideration the spirit of the order passed by this Court on 11.05.2016, the time as granted by this Court will be deemed to have been extended till the date of deposit.

In view thereof, the revision petition is dismissed.
