The husband/petitioner is in revision petition against the order determining maintenance pendente lite to the wife and two minor children.

The husband has been asked to pay Rs.15,000/- per month to the wife and Rs.7500/- each to the minor children.

Learned trial Court after appreciating the facts available on the file has found that the husband is earning reasonable amount and his annual Income- tax Return shows that he is earning approximately Rs.75,000/- per month.

Learned counsel for the petitioner vehemently argued that the husband is already paying electricity charges, transportation charges and school fee of the children.

Once there is an order of the Court, the petitioner is only required to pay according to the order passed by the Court. If the petitioner was making any payment voluntarily, the petitioner would be entitled to

adjust the same while complying with the order passed by the trial Court.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any good ground to interfere with the order passed by the learned trial Court.

The revision petition is dismissed.
