Though as per office report, service *qua* respondent Nos.9 and 28 is not complete, but at this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the service *qua* them be dispensed with in view of the fact that the suit was already dismissed under Order 9 Rule 2 CPC against them.

Petitioner has assailed the order dated 30.11.2015 passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.) Nakodar whereby the application under Order 6 Rule 17 read with Section 151 CPC filed by the plaintiff/petitioner for amendment of the plaint was partially allowed.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

While disposing of the application, the trial Court has noticed that respondent Nos.2, 3, 10, 11, 15, 16, 18, 26 and 27 have made their separate statements to the effect that they have no objection in case the proposed amendment is allowed. Defendant No.6 was proceeded against ex parte and remaining defendants were proceeded in terms of Order 9 Rule 2 CPC. The only contesting respondent was represented by his counsel, who opposed the prayer.

Today learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.1 conceded to the prayer of the petitioner and stated the he has no objection if the prayer for proposed amendment in the plaint is accepted.

In view of statement made by learned counsel for respondent No.1 and in view of no objection raised by majority of the defendants, the present revision petition is disposed of. The proposed amendment is allowed to be carried out in the plaint. Follow up action be taken up. The trial Court shall make every endeavour to decide the suit at the earliest.
