Allowed as prayed for. True photo copies of zimini orders with effect from 15.01.2016 to 29.11.2017 are taken on record subject to just exceptions.

Main case

The petitioner has invoked jurisdiction of this Court under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate directions to the Civil Judge (Senior Division) Ludhiana (executing Court) to decide the execution application pending since 1985.

Perusal of the zimini orders placed on record certainly indicate that the proceedings are not progressing in the manner, it ought to be. On many dates, case has been adjourned for awaiting report on warrants of possession but without any effort by the Court to examine as to why warrants of possession with a report are not being made available to the Court. Without commenting any further, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the District Judge, Ludhiana to keep a watch on progress in execution process so that there is no unnecessary adjournment in the matter and every endeavour is made to bring the proceedings to its logical conclusion.
