The defendants-petitioners are in revision petition against the order dated 12.09.2017 passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Nabha, whereby the application filed by the defendants for de-exhibiting the jamabandi, has been dismissed.

Jamabandi is part of the official record maintained by the Revenue Authorities. Such document is admissible in evidence per se. The Court permitted such evidence to be produced during the course of the trial.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has vehemently submitted that such document does not fall within the scope of the rebuttal evidence.

In the considered opinion of this Court, the certified copy of the jamabandi which is part of the official revenue record maintained by the authorities has been allowed to be produced which would help the Court in

adjudication of the case. No error has been committed by the Court in dismissing the application.

Hence, the revision petition is dismissed.
