Notice of motion was issued on 2.12.2015 on the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners and two months' time was given to the petitioners for making good the due amount as per calculation in accordance with the decree. Petitioners were directed to pay the entire amount as per calculations by 30.1.2016.

On 23.2.2016, it was noticed that the amount has been paid by the petitioners. However, notice could not be issued to the respondent and therefore, fresh process was issued. Thereafter there was no representation on behalf of the petitioners on 20.5.2016 and 28.2.2017.

Today also none has appeared on behalf of the petitioners. It appears that after making payment of the due amount, nothing survives in this revision petition and that is why none has appeared in the aforesaid case.

In view of above, this revision petition is dismissed. However, liberty is given to the petitioners to get it revived in case statement of facts, as noted above, is found to be incorrect.
