The present revision petition is also disposed of in terms of the order passed by this Court in **CWP No.21467 of 2011** titled as **“Samunder and others V/s State of Haryana and others”**, as few of landowners had availed the remedy by filing a civil suit challenging the notification.

The present revision petition arises out of the disposal of the application moved under Order 39 Rules 1 & 2 of the Code of Civil Procedure and dismissal of the miscellaneous appeal. The period of the notification has elapsed, in essence, period of 15 years is over.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances, aforementioned, I deem it appropriate to issue a direction to the trial Court to dispose of the civil suit as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of one year from the date of the receipt of the certified copy of this order as the

petitioner is stated to have taken a plea of title also.

Till the date of disposal of the civil suit, status quo qua possession is ordered to be maintained.
