The petitioner has assailed the order dated 29.09.2015 vide which third party objections filed by the petitioner in the execution of the decree were dismissed.

The order shall have the effect of decree in terms of Order 21 Rule 103 CPC and the same would be appealable in nature.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file appeal before the appropriate Court.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

In case such an appeal is filed, the delay in filing the application shall be decided in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner shall file the appeal within a period of two weeks from today. Till such time, the interim protection granted to the petitioner shall remain in operation. Thereafter, the appellate Court would decide the prayer in accordance with law.
