Defendant-petitioner is in revision petition against the order setting aside the dismissal of the suit in default.

Learned trial Court after appreciating the facts available on the file and after noticing that the restoration application was filed on the same day, has exercised its discretion and restored the suit.

Learned trial Court has further noticed that the suit is for specific performance of the agreement to sell and one of the plaintiff was in custody.

Keeping in view the fact that the learned trial Court has exercised its discretion and allowed the plaintiff to continue with the suit, this Court does not find any error of jurisdiction in the exercise of its discretion.
