Learned Counsel for the petitioner has come to the revision filed against the impugned order dated 09.09.2017 whereby objections filed by the petitioner has been dismissed. A perusal of the order shows vide judgment and decree dated 22.05.2013 a suit had been decreed in favour of his father-Jaswant Singh and suit for possession given in favour of his father-Jaswant Singh. In this present suit, petitioner had taken the stand that this house had been given by way of family arrangement. However, a perusal of the judgment (**Annexure P-1**) shows that even before the trial court no evidence is led with regard to family settlement/arrangement between the parties and petitioner was proceeded against exparte and no appeal filed by him against the exparte judgment (**Annexure P-1**). In the absence of any evidence with regard to family settlement/arrangement, the objections has been dismissed.

No ground to interference in the present revision is made out.
