It is to be noticed that while issuing notice of motion, an assertion had been made by the tenant that the matter could be resolved on account of an amicable resolution of the dispute and notice of motion was issued on the limited point only.

Resultantly, counsel for the respondents has put in appearance. The said proposal has been objected to on the ground that the ejectment application was filed on 22.7.1988. The evidence of the landlord was closed as far as back in the year 1999. Due to proceedings stayed by this Court which the matter had been decided only in 2015, the trial had commenced. It is submitted that there is no chance of amicable settlement as the respondents are not agreed for the same.

Accordingly, the present revision petition is dismissed.
