When the case came up for hearing on 12.12.2016, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Affidavit of Satish Kumar and Yash Pal filed in Court, are taken on record.

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have already deposited lease money at the rate of Rs. 50,000/- per annum even after expiry of the initial lease period of five years with the permission of the court. They are ready to pay lease money at the rate of Rs.70,000/- per annum with effect from expiry of initial period of lease for a period of another five years and undertake to deliver back possession of the property in question on expiry of period of five years with effect from 29.5.2013 i.e. 28.5.2018.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos. 1 and 2 only returnable for 25.1.2017.

In the meantime, the petitioners shall deposit an amount of Rs.1,00,000/- in the Registry of the Court within a period of 15 days. On necessary deposit being made, parties shall maintain status quo with regard to possession. Notice to the

respondents would be issued after deposit and a copy of the order be appended with the notice.”

When the above-said order was not being complied with by the petitioners, learned counsel for the petitioners was granted one more opportunity to seek clear instructions from the petitioners vide order dated 13.9.2017, which reads as under:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks time to get clear instructions as to whether the petitioners wants to comply with the notice of motion order dated 12.12.2016 or wants to withdraw the revision petition.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners has fairly stated that petitioners do not want to comply with the above-said notice of motion order dated 12.12.2016. He further submits that petitioners want to withdraw the present revision petition.

Permission is granted.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
