After perusing the report it transpires that appellant-Mangat Ram was murdered, regarding which FIR No.290 dated 13.11.2012, under Section 302 IPC was registered at Police Station 'A' Division, Amritsar City and the factum regarding death of appellant Mangat Ram stands proved vide Death Certificate issued by the Municipal Corporation, Amritsar, statement of Paramjit Kaur widow of Mangat Ram, statement of Sita daughter of Mangat Ram and Vinod Kumar son of late Mangat Ram and other respectable persons of the locality namely Tarlok singh, Kulwant

Singh and Rinku, who have testified the factum of death of Mangat Ram.

Since the appellant has died and no one had come forward to be arrayed in his place, the present appeal stands dismissed having abated.
