As the matter has been opened for arguments, learned counsel for the respondent submits that he has no objection if the petitioner is allowed extension of time for furnishing bank guarantee in compliance of the order dated 27.08.2015 passed by learned First Appellate Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be given four weeks' time to furnish the bank guarantee.

In view of the submission made by learned counsel for the parties, the instant petition is allowed and the impugned order dated 20.11.2015 passed by learned First Appellate Court is *set aside* and four weeks' time is granted to the petitioner to furnish the bank guarantee.

The petitioner shall submit the bank guarantee on or before 25.05.2017. In case he fails to do so, the impugned order dated 20.11.2015 passed by learned First Appellate Court shall become operative.

In case the bank guarantee is furnished by the petitioner within the time specified above, learned First Appellate Court shall expedite the disposal of the appeal.
