When the case came up for hearing on 24.4.2017, following order was passed by this Court:-

“As per office report, notice sent to the respondent has been received back unserved with the report that he is out of country.

Petitioner to furnish current and correct address of the respondent along with Foreign Registered A.D. and then notice be issued for 21.09.2017.

As per office report dated 19.9.2017, learned counsel for the petitioner has not furnished correct address of respondent. She seeks further adjournment, which has not been found justified. Further, decree has already attained finality against the petitioner as petitioner did not file any second appeal. By way of impugned order dated 24.10.2016, the learned trial court rightly granted two months' more time to the decree holder to deposit the balance sale consideration. Thereafter, much water has flown. Instant revision petition would not even survive as on date and the same is disposed of, accordingly.
