The present revision petition filed by the tenant is directed against the order dated 18.10.2014 (**Annexure P-1**), passed by the learned Appellate Authority, Bhiwani, whereby mesne profits at the rate of ₹ 10,000/- per month, payable with effect from the date of eviction order dated 29.05.2014 qua the demised shop, have been ordered.

This Court vide order dated 18.12.2014, while issuing notice of motion, had reduced the payment of mesne profits to the rate of ₹ 8,000/- per month.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner/tenant states that the present revision petition has become infructuous as the tenanted shop has since been vacated and possession delivered to the landlord.

In view of the statement of learned Counsel for the petitioner/tenant made at bar, the present revision petition is disposed of as infructuous.
