Defendant No.5-petitioner is in revision petition against the order passed by learned trial Court dated 20.11.2017. Learned Court has held that defendants are intentionally delaying the trial of the case on one pretext or the other. The Court has also noticed that defendant No.5 is daughter of Jaipal Singh, who is defendant No.1, whereas defendant No.2 is mother of defendant No.5. The Court has further noticed that plaintiff No.1 is widowed daughter-in-law and plaintiff No.2 is grand-child of defendant No.1.

Taking into consideration the conduct of the parties, this Court does not find any good ground to interfere with the order passed by the Court.

Revision petition is dismissed.
