The present petition was filed challenging the vires of Section 2 (g)(4), 2(g)(6) and Section 5 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation), Act, 1961 (as applicable to Haryana).

Learned counsel for the petitioners fairly submitted that the vires of the aforesaid provisions have been upheld by a Full Bench of this Court in 2003(2) PLR 658 Jai Singh vs State of Haryana and others, and certain directions have been issued.

The aforesaid fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the State.

In view of the fair stand taken by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of in terms of the law laid down in Jai Singh's case (supra).
