Appellant Rakesh alongwith Ram Kishan, Satbir Singh and Chander Bhan was tried for committing the offences punishable under Sections 307/34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act. Vide judgment and order dated 30.5.2005/1.6.2005, learned Additional Sessions Judge (Fast Track Court), Bhiwani acquitted his co-accused of the charges against them. He was, however, convicted under Section 307 IPC and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of five years and to pay a fine of Rs.2,000/- and in default of payment of fine, to further undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of three months. He was also convicted under Section 25 of the Arms Act and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment

for one year and to pay a fine of Rs.1,000/- and in default of payment of fine, to further undergo rigorous imprisonment for two months. Both the substantive sentences were ordered to run concurrently.

Aggrieved of his conviction and sentence, the appellant filed the present appeal, which was admitted on 7.7.2005. Subsequently, vide order dated 2.9.2005, this Court suspended his sentence of imprisonment and ordered his release on bail.

Learned State counsel has placed on record the custody certificate, wherein, it stands mentioned that the appellant was released from the jail on 19.8.2007 after expiry of the sentence imposed upon him. Further, he had already deposited the fine amount.

Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that after being released from custody in the present case, the appellant has not contacted him for pursuing the appeal any further.

In view of the above, the appeal is hereby disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
