JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought quashing of order dated 17.01.2014 passed by learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Patiala whereby the application dated 16.11.2013 (Annexure P-9) seeking recalling of *zimni* orders dated 29.10.2013 and for leading the evidence, has been dismissed.

Learned counsel for the respondents has furnished the certified copy of the statement of Baljit Kaur and Kuldeep Kaur-plaintiffs made before the trial Court as well as the copy of interim order dated 7th April, 2017 which are taken on record.

A perusal of the aforesaid documents transpires that the matter has since been compromised between the parties. In pursuance of statement, the instant *Civil Revision No.977 of 2014* is to be withdrawn and cannot be proceeded with rather it has rendered infructuous.

Accordingly, the instant petition stands disposed of as having

been rendered infructuous.

However, in case any of the parties wriggles out of the terms of the compromise/statement and the cause of action still survives, petitioner shall be at liberty to get it revived.
