After arguing the case for some time and realising that he will not be in a position to substantiate his arguments on merits, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of the court to withdraw the present revision petition with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh suit in terms of the order dated 9.10.2010 (Annexure P-2).

Permission is granted.

Should there be any confusion, it is also clarified that order dated 9.10.2010 passed by learned Civil Judge (Jr. Division), Karnal, even if passed under an erroneous impression, will not stand in the way of the petitioner to seek her appropriate remedy, before learned court of competent jurisdiction by filing a fresh suit, as and when necessity arises.

With the abovesaid observations made, present revision petition stands disposed of.
