Defendant Nos. 2 to 5 are in the civil revision petition against the order passed by the learned Trial Court, striking off their defence on the ground that within the prescribed time, written statement has not been filed, although four effective opportunities have already been granted.

Although it is appreciable for the Courts to expedite the trial of the case, however due to unforeseen circumstances some time delay occurs.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the counsel representing them did not inform and hence the petitioners have already changed their counsel.

Taking into consideration these facts, the petitioners are granted one more opportunity to file their written statement, subject to payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- which shall be payable to the plaintiff by way of demand draft.

Written statement be filed within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Since this order has been passed without issuing notice to the respondents, so they would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for recall, if they feel aggrieved.

Accordingly the present revision petition is disposed of.
