In the instant writ petition, petitioner's grievance is relating to not considering his name and promoting him to the post of Special Foreman (Mechanical).

The petitioner is in the cadre of Foreman and he fulfilled the 5 years of experience qualification in the concerned trade. Thus, he is eligible for promotion to the post of Foreman Special (Mechanical). The respondents in the year 2007 proposed to fill up certain Forman Special (Mechanical) and other trades posts. However, the same has not been proceeded to for the reasons best known to them. During pendency of this petition, petitioner is stated to have attained the age of superannuation and retired from service in the year 2004. Thus, in view of the retirement

whether petitioner is entitled for any retrospective promotion to the post of

Foreman Special (Mechanical) Trade or not. The respondents are hereby directed to find out whether any vacancy has occurred during the period from 1997 to 2004 or not. If a vacancy has occurred in the cadre of Foreman Special (Mechanical) Trade in that event petitioner's name shall be considered for retrospective promotion and extending all other benefits. The above exercise shall be completed by the concerned respondent within a period of four months from today. If the petitioner is promoted, he be extended monetary and other service benefits from the date of promoting him to the post of Foreman Special (Mechanical).

With the above observations, petition stands disposed of.
