None appears on behalf of the petitioners despite the fact that the case was called twice.

I have heard learned counsel for the State and perused the record.

The instant writ petition has been filed with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari quashing the impugned order dated 28.4.1993 (Annexure P/7) and order dated 8.10.1992 (Annexure P/6) to the extent initial start of Rs. 1920/- in the scale of Rs. 1800-3200 has been restricted only to Senior Assistant and Senior Scale Stenographers of Secretariat office with a further writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant initial start of Rs. 1920/- in the pay scale of Rs. 1800-3200 to the petitioners from 1.1.1986 and also grant Rs. 120/- per month as additional pay in pursuance of the letter dated 28.7.1993 (Annexure P/8).

The petitioners herein claim the same benefit as was given to the petitioners in CWP No. 1854 of 1993. The judgment in CWP No. 1854 of 1993 came to be challenged in the LPA No. 331 of 1994. Therefore, the writ petition was ordered to be listed for hearing after decision of LPA No. 331 of 1994 .

This matter has been put up for hearing after decision of the aforesaid LPA. The learned Division Bench, after hearing arguments at length, allowed the LPA and dismissed the writ petition. Since the matter is squarely covered by the decision of the LPA No. 331 of 1994, no further orders are called for and the writ petition is dismissed.
