Learned counsel for the respondents point out that in this case the petitioner had challenged the allotment of house to respondent No.4 on the ground that he was senior to respondent No.4 since he was working as Senior Scale Stenographer while respondent No.4 was a Junior Auditor. However, during the pendency of this writ petition, the petitioner has now become Assistant Director while respondent No.4 has become Superintendent and both have shifted into larger houses and consequently this writ petition has been rendered infructuous and may be dismissed as such.
