The applicant-appellant has impugned judgment dated 10.1.2014 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge (Exclusive Court of the Cases of Heinous Crime Against Women), Karnal whereby respondent Nos. 2 to 4 have been acquitted of the charges under Sections 363, 366-A/34 IPC.

When the matter was taken up on 1.2.2017 the following order was passed:-

“There was no representation on behalf of the appellant on the last two occasions. Today also none appears on behalf of the appellant.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 18.4.2017.

In case there is no representation on behalf of the appellant on the next date of hearing, this appeal may be dismissed for non-prosecution.”

Despite the matter having been called out twice today, there is again no representation on behalf of the appellant.

Appeal is consequently dismissed for non-prosecution.
