Through this appeal, prayer has been made for enhancement of sentence awarded to respondents No. 2 and 3 in Sessions case no. 61 of 2010 vide judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 19.11.2011 passed by learned Sessions Judge, Amritsar, whereby, respondents No. 2 and 3 were held guilty and convicted for commission of offence under Section 323 and 324 IPC in case FIR No. 201 dated 17.10.2008 pertaining to Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar, but were ordered to be released on probation.

Since, the aforesaid FIR has been quashed on the basis of compromise entered into between the parties vide order of even date passed by this Court in CRM-M-18597 of 2016 and impugned judgment has been set aside, the instant appeal has rendered infructuous and is dismissed as such.
