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The present writ petition is by the petitioner challenging the order dated 26.3.1996 (Annexure P-7) by virtue of which the disciplinary authority taking the lenient view, his punishment of dismissal from service was reduced to that of forfeiture of one year approved service with permanent effect for increment. It was also ordered that the period spent out of service shall be treated as non-duty period and he shall not be entitled to any pay and allowances for this period. However, he will be eligible to get his pay and other usual allowances from the date he rejoins his service.
