Reply by way of affidavit of Navjot Pal Singh Randhawa, Deputy Secretary, Department of Tourism, Government of Punjab, dated 4/9.05.2017 on behalf of respondent No.1 filed today in Court, is taken on record.

The petitioner approached this Court praying for quashing of notifications issued under Section 4 and 6 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 dated 19.12.1994 and 09.08.1995, respectively.

In the affidavit filed today, definite stand taken by the State is that project proposed for setting up of tourist complex, Ferozepur, for which the land was sought to be acquired, has been dropped and the State does not require the land in question.

Considering the aforesaid stand taken by the learned State counsel, in our opinion the present petition has been rendered infructuous

and the same deserves to be disposed of as such.
