RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J

This petition was filed in 1999 challenging an order passed by the Assistant Labour Commissioner, Union Territory, Chandigarh, refusing to entertain the complaint of the petitioner under Section 25U of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947. The petitioner had filed a complaint to prosecute the respondent/employer arising out of the dispute as to transfer of the petitioner arising between the workman and the management. The Assistant Labour Commissioner correctly reasoned that the action of the employer in transferring the petitioner does not relate to curbing the activities of any union or the Union itself. By the order dated 27.05.1999 (Annexure P/1), the petitioner was advised that in case he thought his transfer was mala fide, he was free to approach the labour Court and press his case before that forum for vindication of his grievance.

After 18 years, no life is left in this petition and the same is ordered to be accordingly, dismissed.
