Today learned counsel for the petitioner has brought to our notice that in fact while making the payment to the respondent-workman under Section 17-B of the Industrial Disputes Act more payment was made inasmuch as the payment continued upto the age of 69 years to the respondent-workman though by that time he had already attained the age of superannuation. Further, he has stated that the petitioner-Company is lying closed since more than 30 years. None has appeared on behalf of respondent-workman.

In the aforesaid circumstances, we consider it appropriate at this stage to order consignment of the case to record-room with liberty to the

parties, to get the case revived in accordance with law, if circumstances so exist.
