As per office report, service of this case is complete. However, none has appeared. Perusal of file shows that it was stated on behalf of the petitioner before the Hon'ble High Court on February 17, 1999 that the amount as awarded by labour Court would be paid to the respondent, who is blind. Further perusal of file shows that a sum of ₹10,000/- was awarded in favour of respondent No.2. Further perusal of order dated May 3, 1999 shows that an amount of ₹10,000/- was already paid to respondent No.2. Today, nobody has appeared, despite service. Hence, we are of the view that the present writ petition seems to have become infructuous and it seems that petitioner does not want to pursue any further.

However, as nobody is appearing on behalf of the parties, despite service, the present writ petition is ordered to be consigned to the record room with liberty to the parties to get it revived, if so desire.
