The applicant-appellants have filed the present application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.11 dated 02.02.2010 registered under Sections 458, 326, 325, 324, 323, 148 & 149 IPC at Police Station Nurmahal, District Jalandhar and as a sequel the judgment and order dated 23.02.2016 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar in SC No.29615 of 2014 dated 23.02.2016, in view of compromise/compounding.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned counsel appearing for complainant submits that compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

This Court had made order dated 20.03.2017 in this application asking for recording of statement in order to find out the correctness and genuineness of the compromise said to have been arrived at between the parties.

Accordingly, statements have been recorded by the trial Court and report has been received by this Court. Looking to the report it is seen that the compromise is voluntary and genuine. I have seen the offences registered against the appellants and the impugned judgment and order. Looking to the nature of the offences I think the compromise/compounding should be allowed.

In view of the above, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRM-32564-2016 in CRA-S-925-SB OF 2016 is allowed.
- (ii) The FIR No.11 dated 02.02.2010 registered under Sections 458, 326, 325, 324, 323, 148 & 149 IPC at Police Station Nurmahal, District Jalandhar along with judgment and order dated 23.02.2016 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar in SC No.29615 of 2014, are quashed along with all consequential proceedings, qua the petitioners by way of compounding/compromise.
- (iii) CRA-S-925-SB OF 2016 is thus disposed of.
